# SALT DOUGH ORNAMENTS

🕒 10 minutes prep

🕒 3-4 hours baking



## Ingredients

---

1 Cup plain flour (250g)

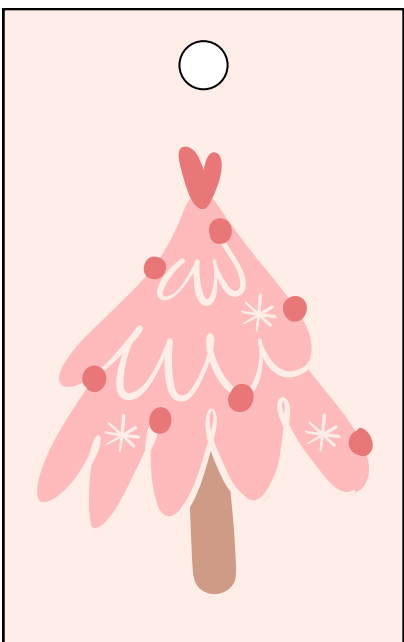
1/2 cup table salt (125g)

1/2 cup water (125ml)

## Method

---

1. Set oven to lowest heat.
2. Combine all ingredients in a bowl until it comes together
3. Roll the salt dough onto a silicone mat or lightly floured bench to a thickness of around 5mm.
4. Use biscuit cutters to shape your ornaments.
5. Press the tip of a piping nozzle into the top of each shape to make a hole. Use a pencil if you do not have a nozzle. Don't make it too close to the edge or it won't hold the ribbon.
6. Bake ornaments for around 3-4 hours until solid. Leave to cool completely.
7. Decorate with acrylic paint, felt pens, glitter (if you're crazy lol) and then tie your ribbon through the hole and hang on the tree.
